

PUBLIC DISCLOSURE

Pursuant Art. 14.3.2 of the FIM Anti-Doping Rules

- Kleber Justino (the rider) underwent a doping control on 17 September 2023 during the 2023 FIM SuperMoto World Championship, where urine samples were collected. The analysis of the sample A revealed the presence of Anastrozole (S4. Hormone and Metabolic Modulator), a substance banned by the WADA 2023 List of Prohibited Substances and Methods.
- 2. Upon receipt of the Adverse Analytical Finding (AAF), the FIM notified the rider and the latter submitted his explanations jointly with his evidence.
- 3. In view of the rider's admission and acceptance of the consequences proposed by the FIM, it has been decided that the rider:
 - is found to have committed an anti-doping rule violation pursuant article 2.1 and/or 2.2 of the FIM Anti-Doping rules, applicable to the 2023 FIM SuperMoto World Championship.
 - ii. is sanctioned with a period of ineligibility twenty-four (24) months, starting on 12 November 2023 (i.e. the date when the provisional voluntary suspension started) as a consequence of the ADRV committed pursuant art. 2.1 and/or 2.2 of the FIM Anti-Doping Rules.
 - iii. All competitive results obtained by the rider from and including 12 November 2023 are disqualified, with all resulting consequences (including for forfeiture of medals, points and prizes).
