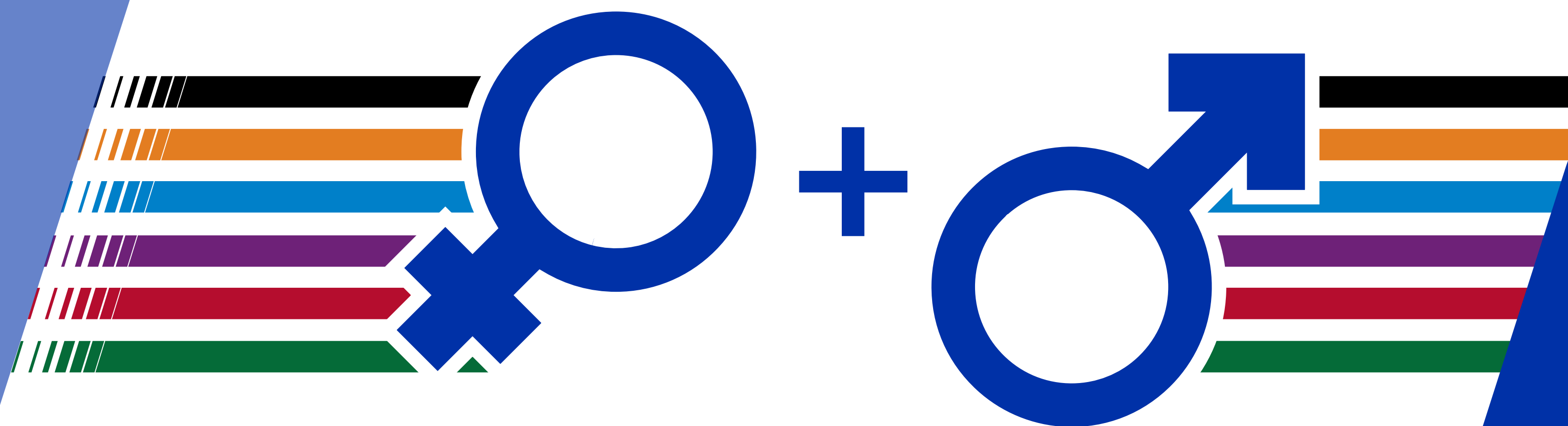
- A New Teams Competition format between **6 FIM Continental Unions**

Each Continental Union selects 4 riders including one (*minimum*) female rider per category.



In each team, **1** male and **1** female “experienced rider” permanently attending to an **FIM World Championship** can be accepted.

- **Dunlop** as Tyres Official Partner

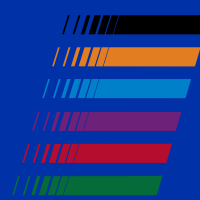

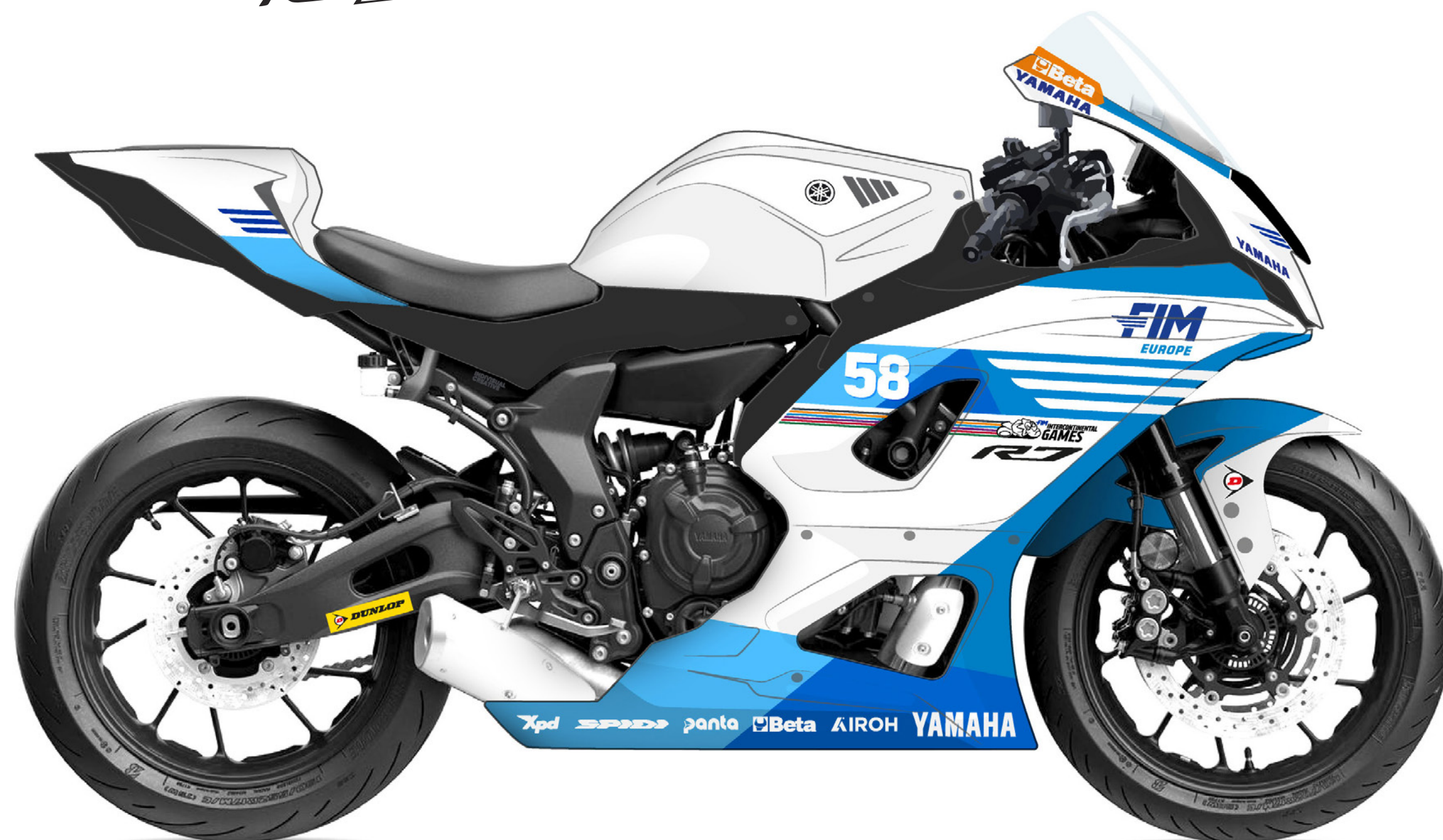

INTERCONTINENTAL Games points & classification

For each race, the riders will score Intercontinental Games Points as follow:

Position	1st	2nd	3rd	4th	5th	...	24th
ICG Points	24	23	22	21	20	...	1

Riders scoring DNS, DNF, DSQ or Retired will score 0 point.
The Intermediate and Final Intercontinental Games Classifications will be done by adding the Intercontinental Games points awarded during the Tournament per each rider of each Continental Unions Team.

Best Man and Woman will be also awarded both on the R3 and R7 categories.

If the tie persists in the Final Intercontinental Game Classification, the advantage will be given to the team whose female rider made the best score in the last race.

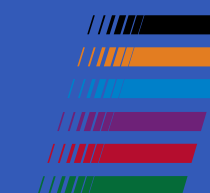
